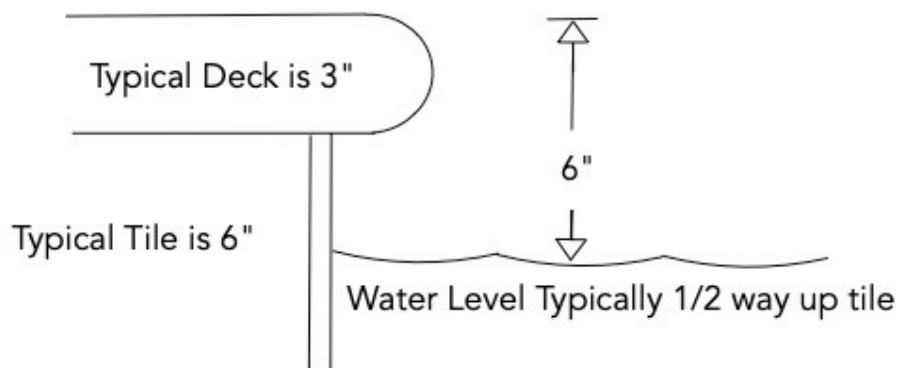

Heavy Rain / Tropical Storm

Please bear in mind these are our typical recommendations for emergency rainfall situations, however you know your property best and need to do whatever is necessary to protect it. Damage to grass and landscaping can result from draining pool.

Due to changes in paths and rainfall amounts wait until correct predictions are made for your area. This is typically 24-48 hours before severe weather starts.

If your home has no chance of water coming into it from pool then draining may not be needed. If drains are working properly this should divert majority of the water.



- ** Skimmer needs to be Off to Drain water below tile.
- ** You can turn Off Power to equipment after draining if desired.
- ** Typical pool can accept 6" of water before even with deck

If estimated rainfall over 2-3 day storm period is:

6" rain drain 3" (about bottom of tile)

10" rain drain 7" (about 4" below tile)

12" rain drain 9" (about 4" above jets)

If your pool does not have a standard drain line most filters are equipped with a drain plug in the bottom.

Turn pump off, remove plug, pump on til desired water out pump off, plug back in.
